Mount Snow has an array of terrain for riders and skiers of every ability level. Hop on the Grand Summit Express, their high-speed quad that gets you to the most breathtaking views Southern Vermont has to offer. Duck into The Trials, located on the extreme western edge of the North Face; during a gentle snowfall, the only noise you hear is the sound of your own heart beating with excitement after finding a stash of untracked powder. Head over to Deer Run, Snow's famous mile-long cruiser—the perfect trail to practice things like ground tricks, riding switch or linking turns. Just after the turnoff to Ridge, Deer Run extends for about 400 yards on a perfectly straight course. If you catch conduroy here in the morning with the sun rising above the ridge, you'll know why "ski burns" give up a career to be on the mountain every day.
